## Our Organization

TDEC is organized and administered to effectively protect human health and the environment, conserve natural resources, manage state parks and promote overall quality of life in Tennessee.

#### Environmental Protection

Our department is the chief environmental and natural resource regulatory agency in Tennessee. We have delegated responsibility from the U.S. EPA to regulate sources of:

- Air pollution
- Solid and hazardous waste
- Radiological health issues
- Underground storage tanks
- Water pollution, water supply and groundwater

Our department has eight environmental field offices located across the state. We offer a program of grants and loans to assist local communities with the development and maintenance of drinking water and wastewater infrastructure as well as solid waste disposal, waste prevention, plus programs for recycling, parks, greenways and trails. We promote both front-end environmental education and strong, effective enforcement.

# **TDEC and its permitting system**

- "The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) is organized and administered to effectively protect human health <u>and</u> the environment, conserve natural resources, manage state parks and promote overall quality of life in Tennessee......<u>while preserving maximum employment and</u> <u>enhancing the industrial development of the State."</u>
- TDEC is mandated by state and federal laws (EPA) to accomplish these goals by issuing permits ...... protect the air and water quality, environment, and citizens health from all types of industrial and residential developments.
- CONFUSING Regulations / Permitting for air, water, and quarries are very confusing and often contradictory.
- COMPLEX EXAMPLE The Jumpoff quarry will require many permits

# **PERMIT TYPES**

- AIR -WATER (Streams and Wetlands) -STORMWATER (discharge) -Tenn Multi-Sector Permit (TMSP)

# **Permit types explained**


□ <u>AIR</u> - contaminant permits for construction and operating - Can be combined for one site. Requires public comment.

WATER - Aquatic Resource Alteration Permit (ARAP). Required for alteration of streams or wetlands such as installing a culvert, flooding or filling in a wetland, dredging, excavating, or straightening a stream etc. "General" permit is allowed if there is minor impact to the water resource. No public comment required.

STORMWATER - National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit is required for stormwater mixed with industrial wastewater that is discharged into a waterway (washing/crushing/grinding sandstone). Requires a wastewater holding basin. Includes SWPPP. General - no public comment - Individual requires public comment.

Tennessee Multi-Sector Permit (TMSP) is a less regulated subtype of NPDES. Includes a Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) with only stormwater discharge. The "general" TMSP requires no public comment. Example - quarry excavation /blasting.

## TDEC Data and Map Viewers

The department manages a variety of critical work through active databases. To promote greater transparency, accountability, and wider access to public information, the department makes interfaces, called Dataviewers, available to the public on our website. Dataviewers pull information from the same consolidated databases TDEC staff use to keep track of environmental regulatory activities, rosters and status.

#### Key to Remember

Dataviewers reflect overnight updates to our agency's consolidated state databases. Information in this dynamic database is constantly changing as records are updated daily. Any change made to the database should be available to the Dataviewer the next day.



Check accept box to access the viewer. Click (+) continuously to enlarge the map northwest of Chattanooga until you see grid 0094NE-7 (Tinsley property area). Then click on a registered well # for all the details on that well. On the bottom of the list, click on "more info" for the drillers report for depth of the well, geologic formations, and soil types. Registering wells started around 1997. You can "Ask TDEC" if your well can be registered.



## How to make public comments

- 1. The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation will first request public comments on the proposed permit actions.
- 2. TDEC says that obtaining a broad range of facts and opinions on Agency actions is one of the best ways to ensure quality decisions.
- 3. Persons wishing to comment on the proposed permit actions may submit comments in writing to the Mining Section at the Knoxville Environmental Field Office, Attn: Public Notice Coordinator; by fax to (865) 594-6105; or by e-mail to Dennis.Conger@tn.gov.
- 4. Comments must be received before the close of the comment period (starting date is listed in the announcement have 30 days).

## How to request a public hearing

1. Request in writing that the Division hold a public hearing on the application.

Attn: Public Notice Coordinator. Division of Mining and Geologic Resources, Knoxville EFO, 3711 Middlebrook Pike, Knoxville TN 37921.

- 2. The request must be filed before the close of the 30 day comment period.
- 3. You must state your interest in requesting a hearing, the reason that such a hearing is warranted, and the water quality issues being raised.
- 4. When there is a significant public interest for a hearing, the Division will hold a hearing in accordance with Rule 0400-40-05-.06 (12).
- 5. A separate public notice will announced the hearing.
